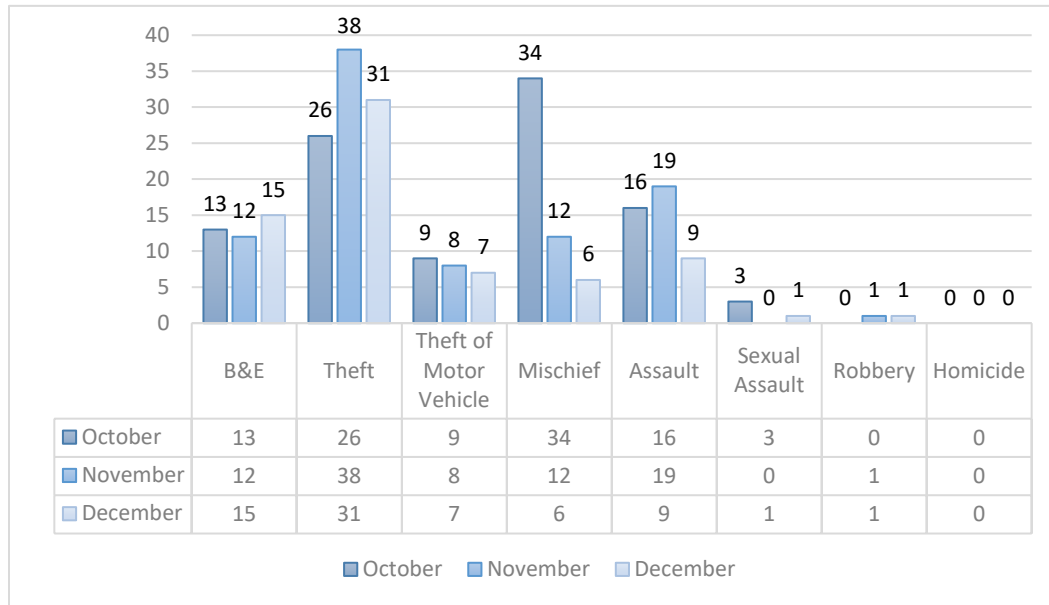

## Overview:

Break and Enter occurrences rose from 12 reported occurrences in November, 2019 to 15 reported occurrences in December, 2019. These occurrences involved break and enters to businesses, compounds, storage units, garages and sheds where a variety of items were stolen.

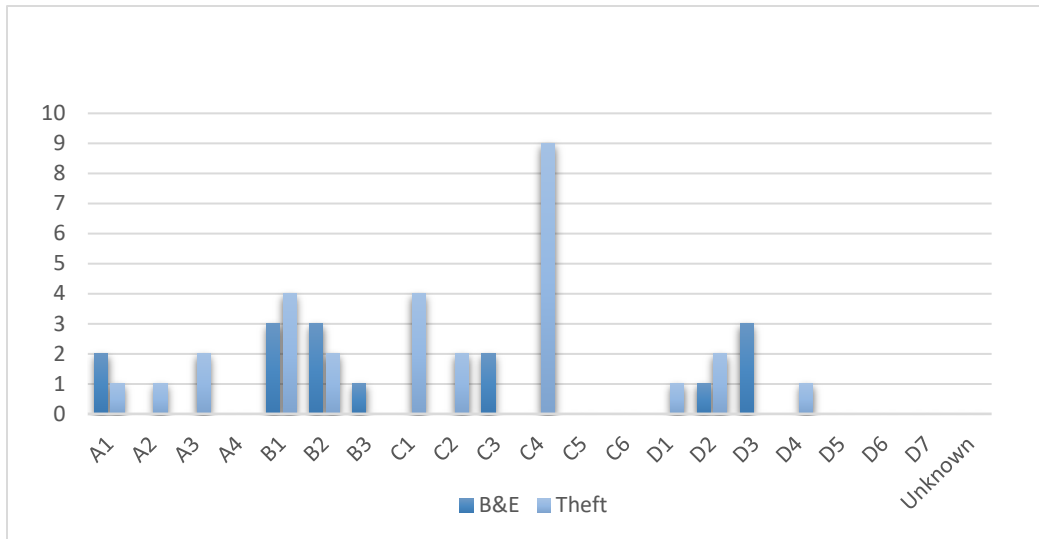
In comparison to December 2018, break and enter occurrences rose 200%, increasing from 5 reported occurrences in December 2018 to 15 reported occurrences in December 2019.

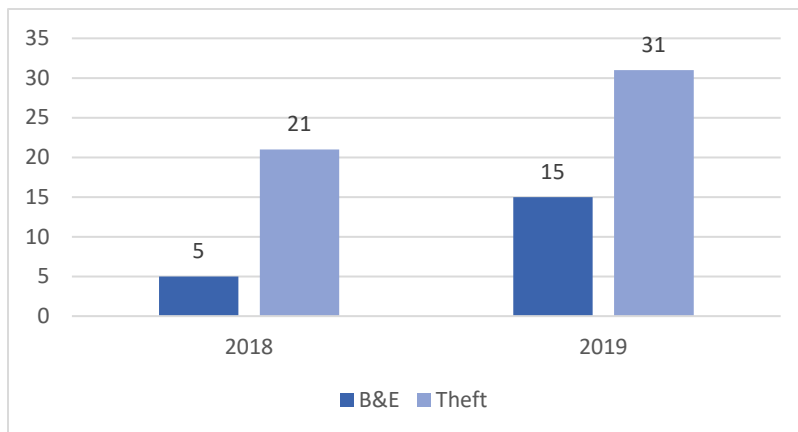
Information obtained from daily stats collections which varied by the end of the month due to scoring changes as a result of Police investigation.

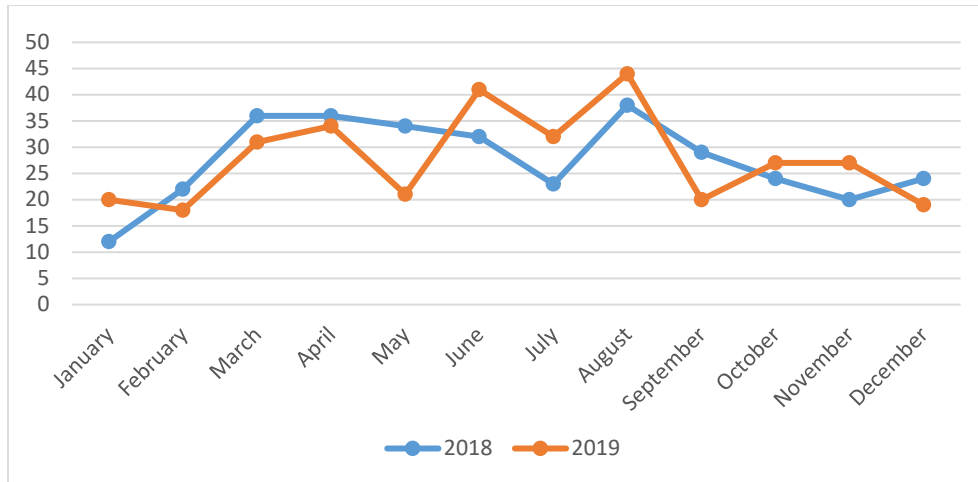
## Occurrence Zones Break & Enter and Thefts



## December 2018 to December 2019 Break & Enter and Thefts

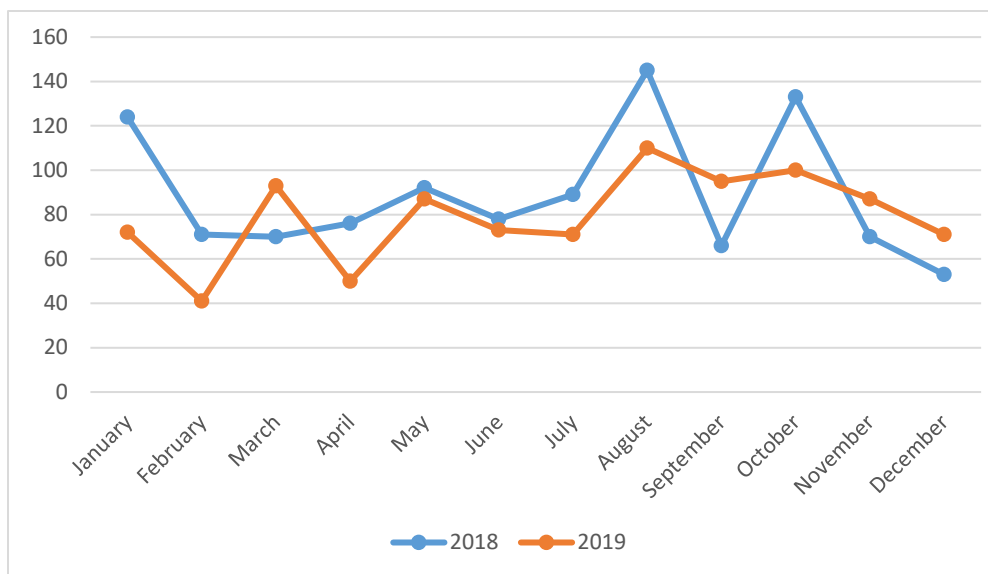


## Crimes Against Persons 5 Year Monthly Average – 24



The total number of Crimes against Persons was 19 in December of 2019, compared to 24 in December of 2018.

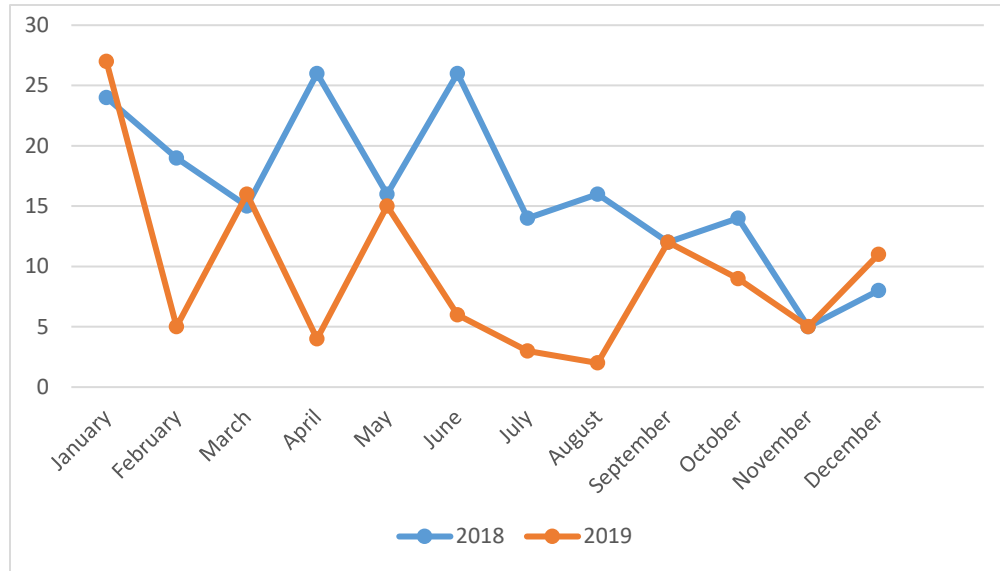
## Crimes Against Property 5 Year Monthly Average – 84

### 5 Year Monthly Average – 22



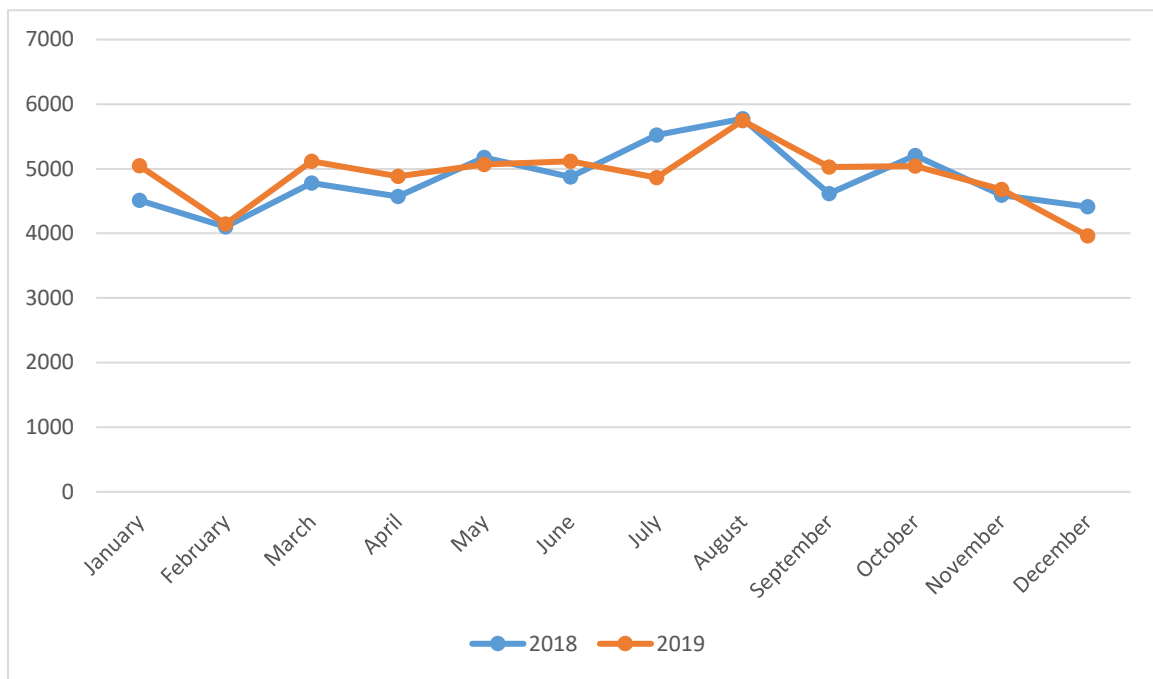
There were 11 drug offence occurrences in December of 2019, compared to 8 occurrences in December of 2018.

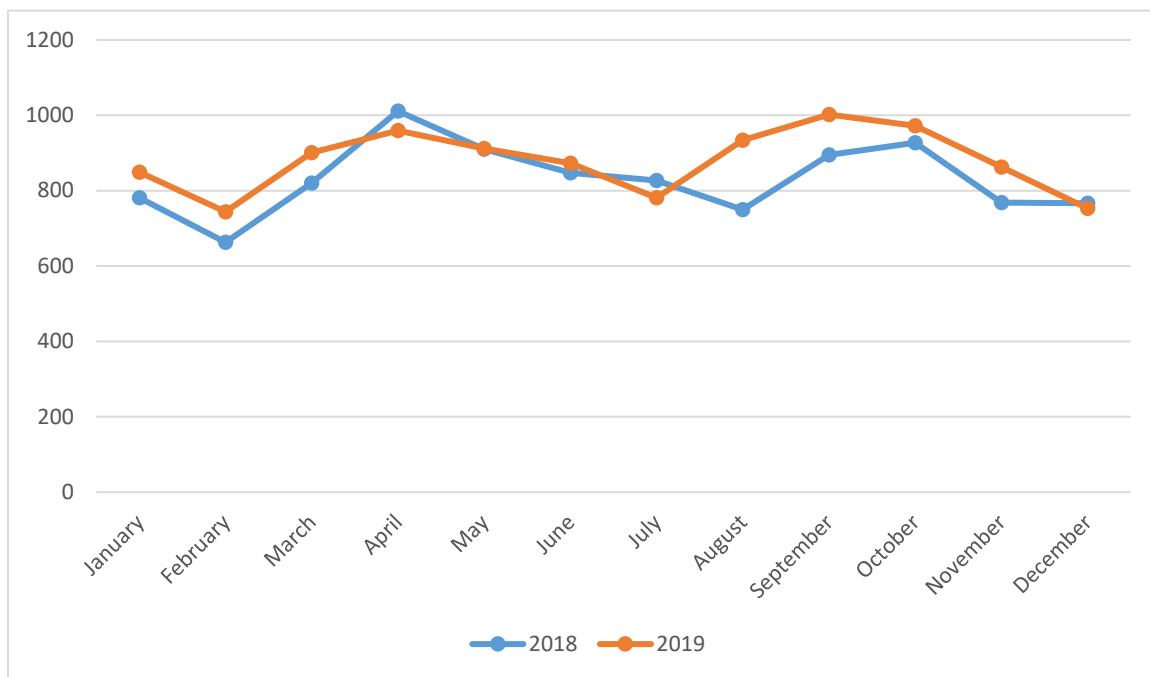

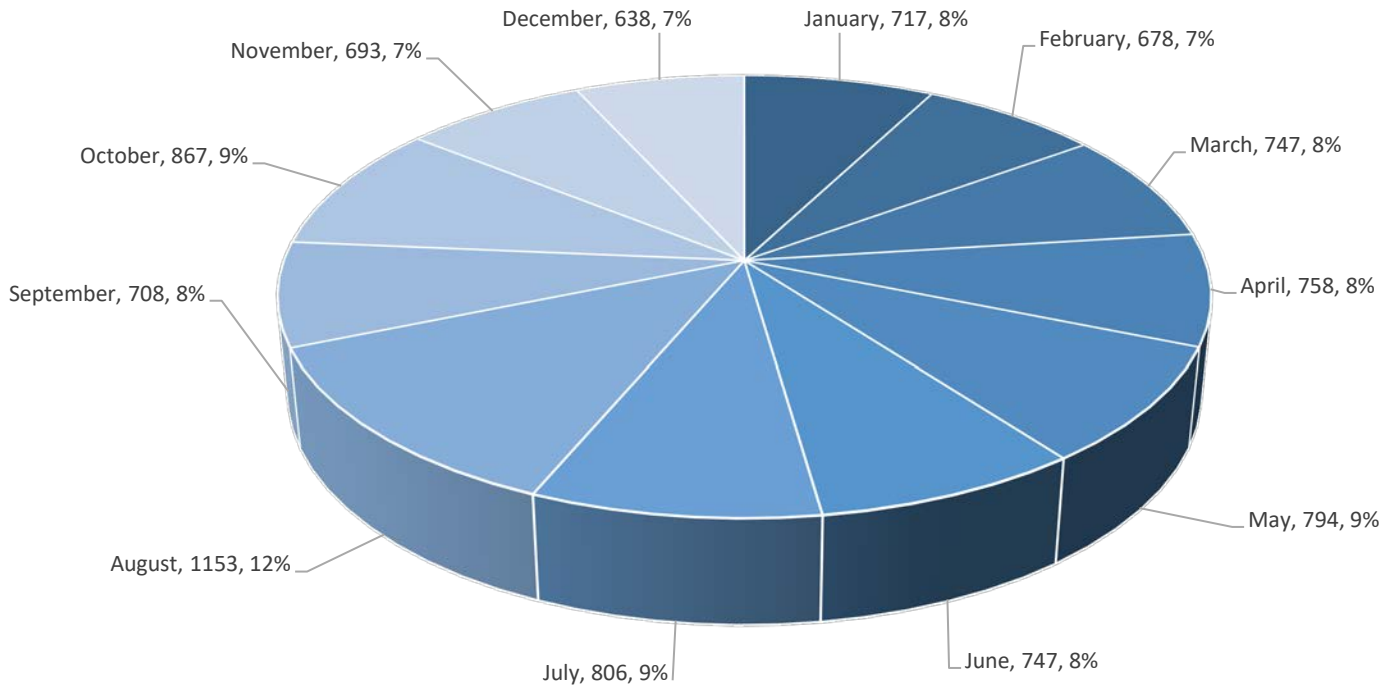

Number of Occurrences in 2019

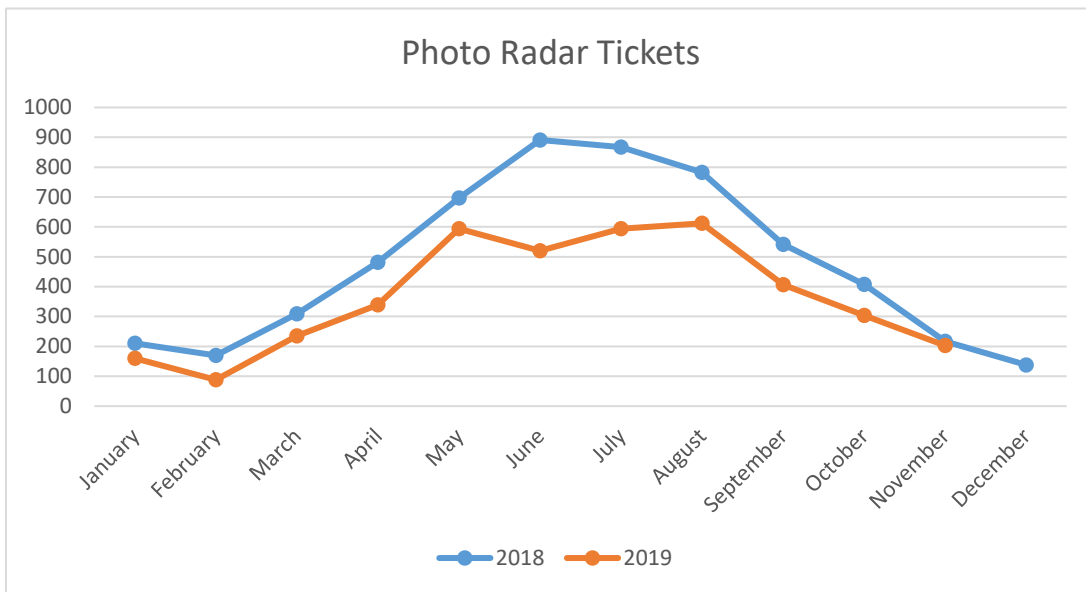
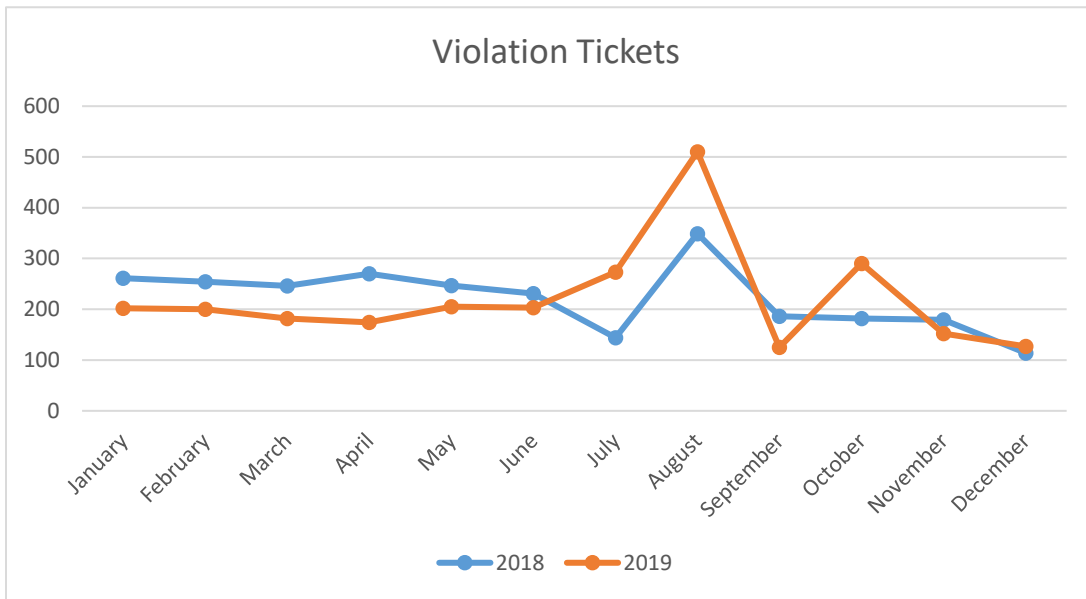

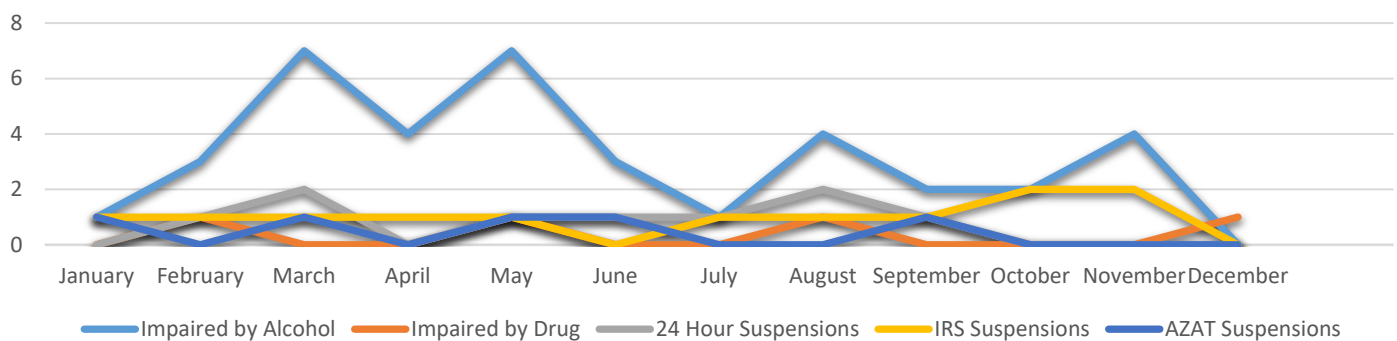
