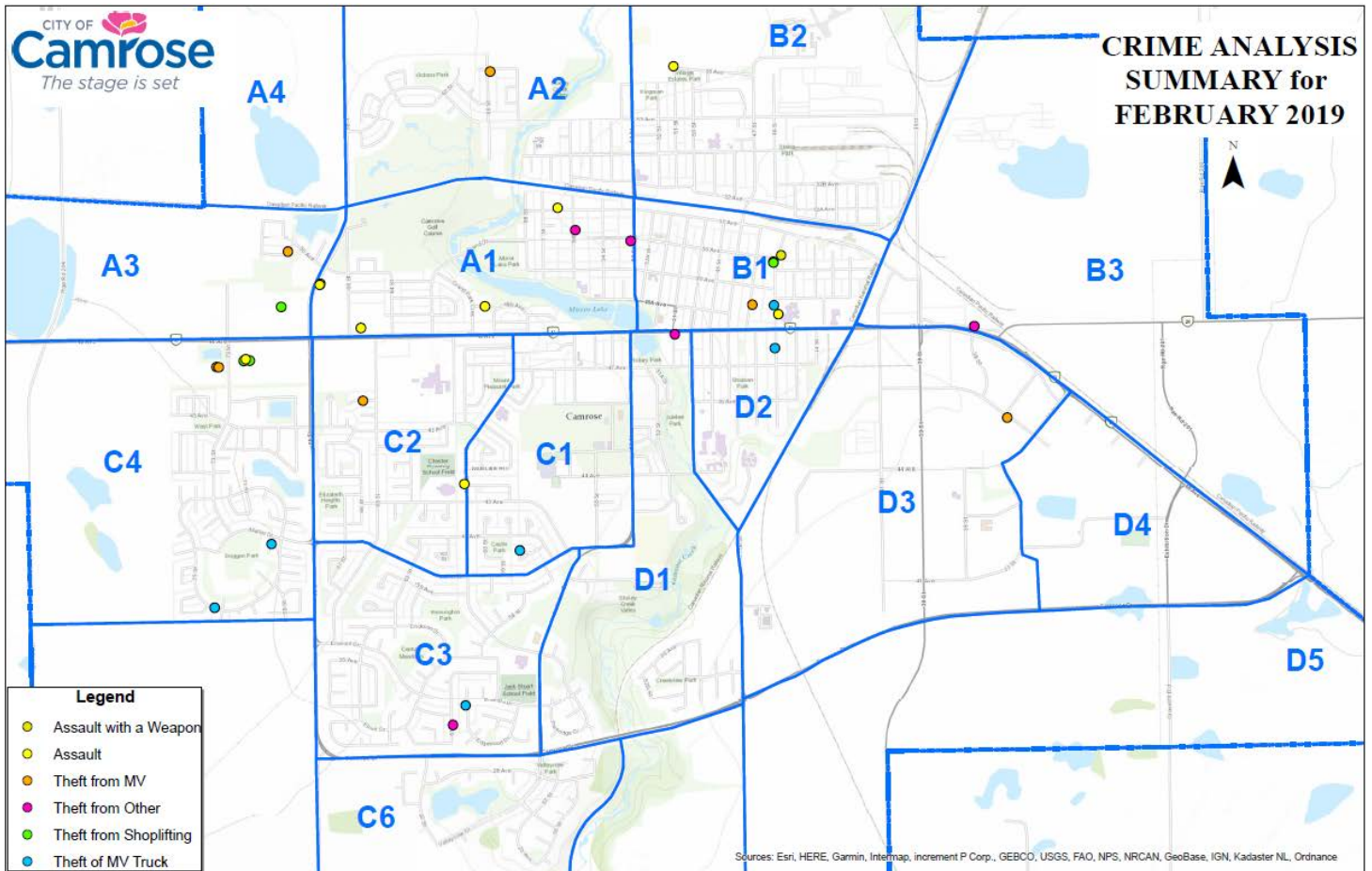
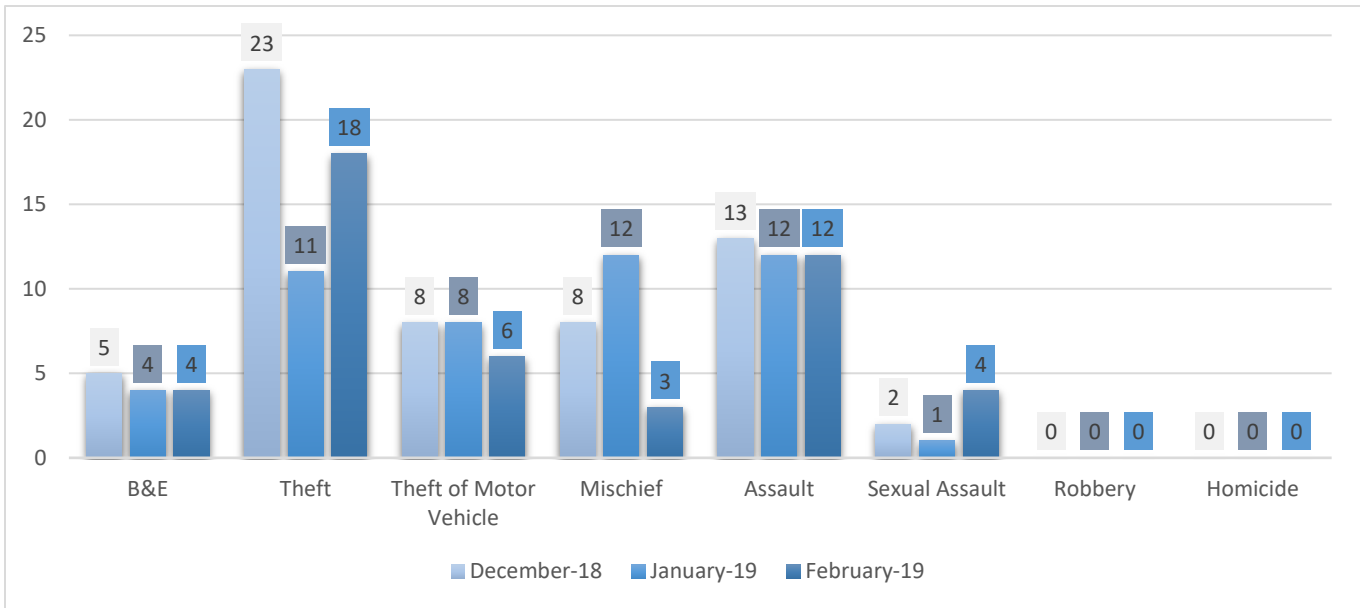

Overview:

February 2019 recorded the lowest monthly total of the Eight Crime Indicators compared to all of 2018 and thus far into 2019.

The category of Theft increased 64%, from 11 reported occurrences in January 2019, to 18 reported occurrences in February 2019. Even though the percentage increase appears significant, the 18 reported occurrences are well below the February 2018 stat of 35 reported occurrences. An identified trend in this category was the theft of exhaust systems/catalytic converters from parked vehicles. In the month of February 2019, there were four (4) reported incidents received involving five (5) vehicles.

The only other category in the Eight Crime Indicators to increase was Sexual Assaults. An analysis of these four (4) reported occurrences determined that one (1) reported occurrences was historic and the remaining three (3) reported occurrences are alleged to have occurred over a month prior to the reported date.

In two (2) of the reported occurrences, both victims requested no Police investigation, and one (1) of the reported occurrences was reassigned to another jurisdiction for inclusion with their investigations.

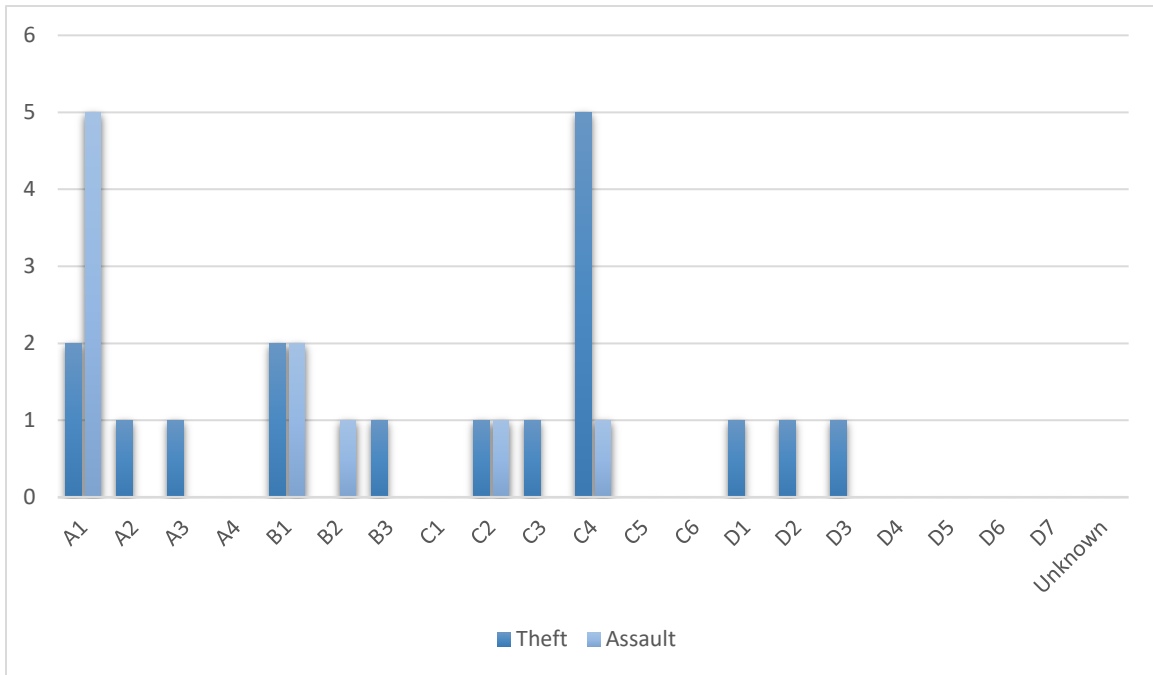
The remaining categories remained consistent with the previous two months, excluding Mischief which saw a decrease of nine (9) reported occurrences (-75%).

Eight Crime Indicators

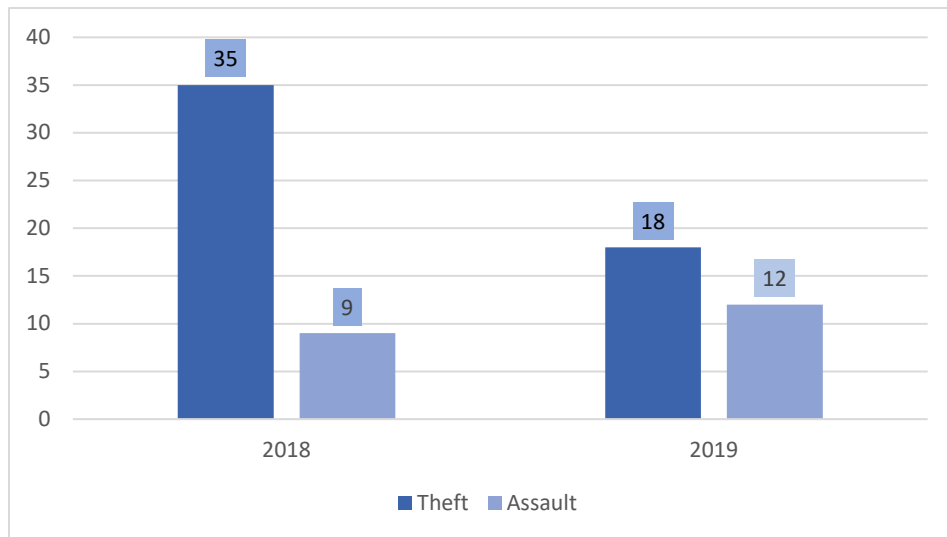
Information obtained from daily stats collections which varied by the end of the month due to scoring changes as a result of Police investigation.

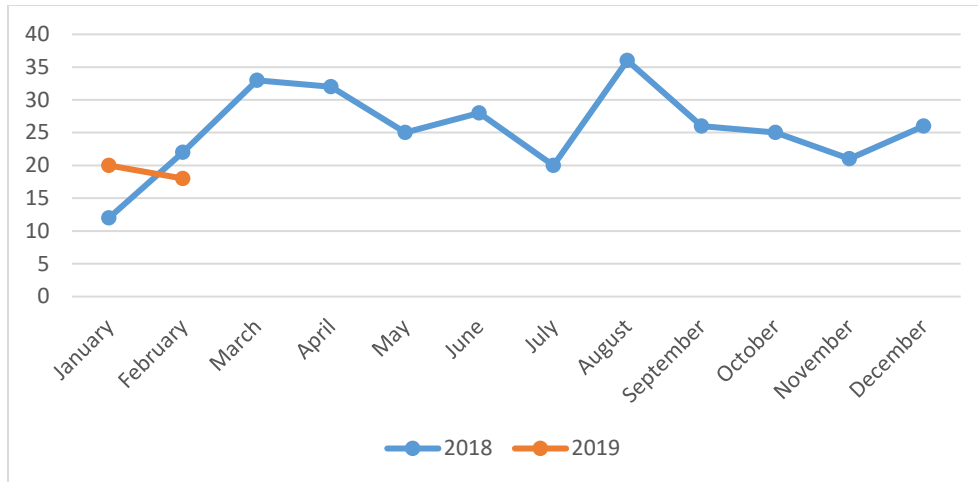
Theft & Assault – Occurrence Zones



Theft & Assault February 2018 to February 2019

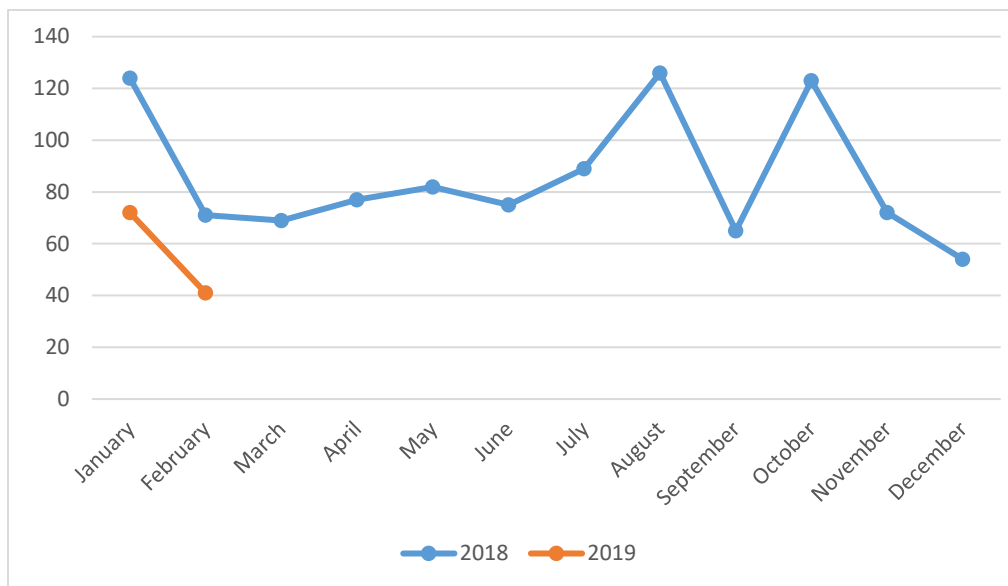


Crimes Against Persons 5 Year Monthly Average – 24



The total number of Crimes against Persons was 18 in February of 2019, compared to 22 in February of 2018.

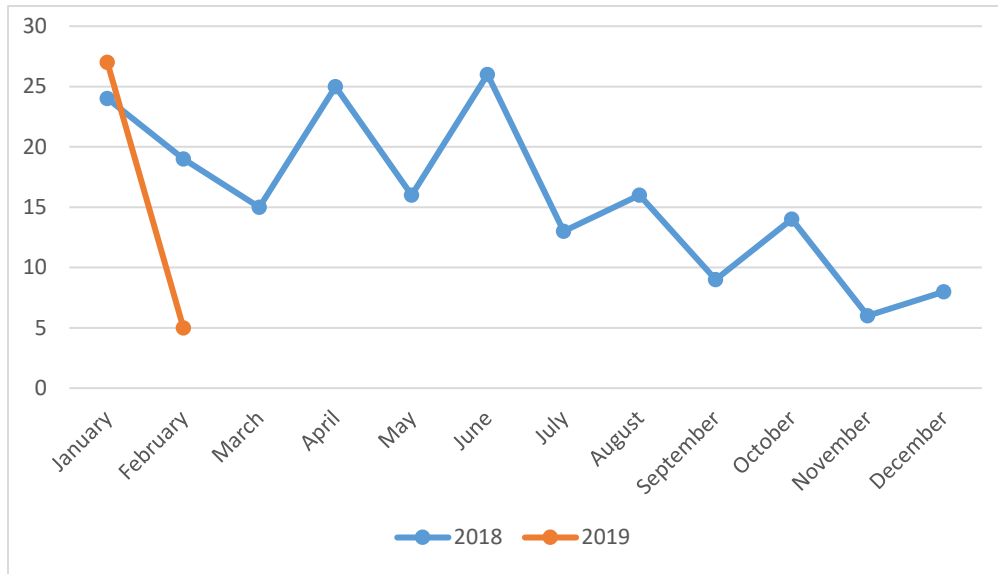
Crimes Against Property 5 Year Monthly Average – 84

5 Year Monthly Average – 22



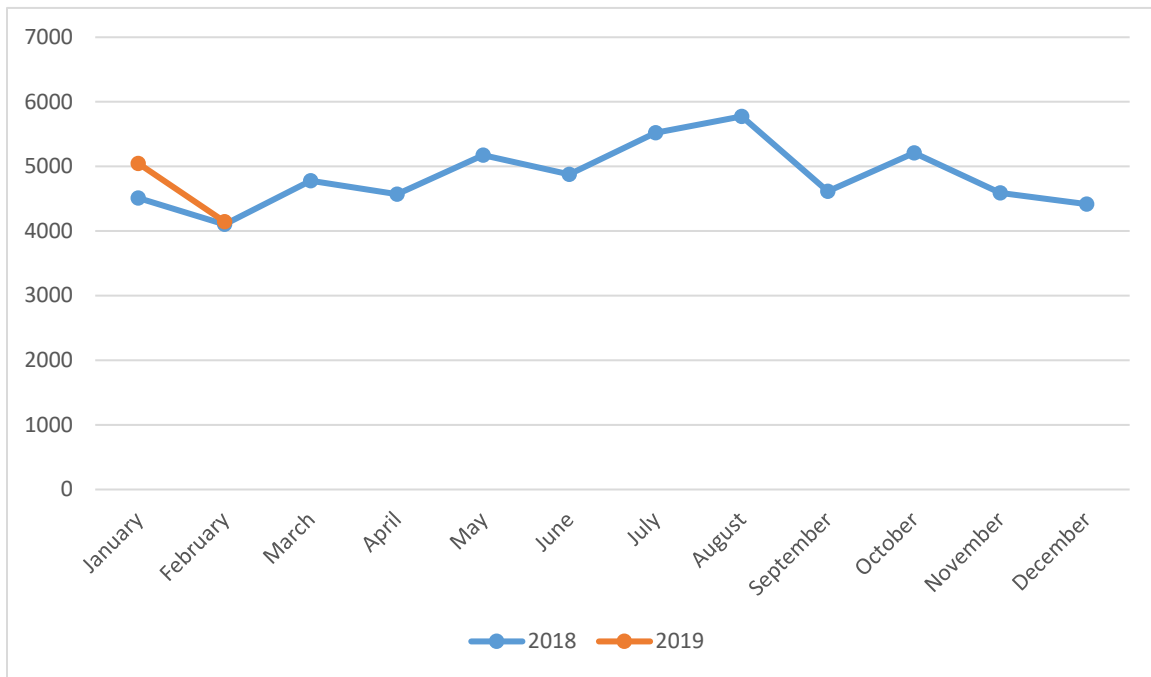
There were 5 drug offence occurrences in February of 2019, compared to 19 in February of 2018.
