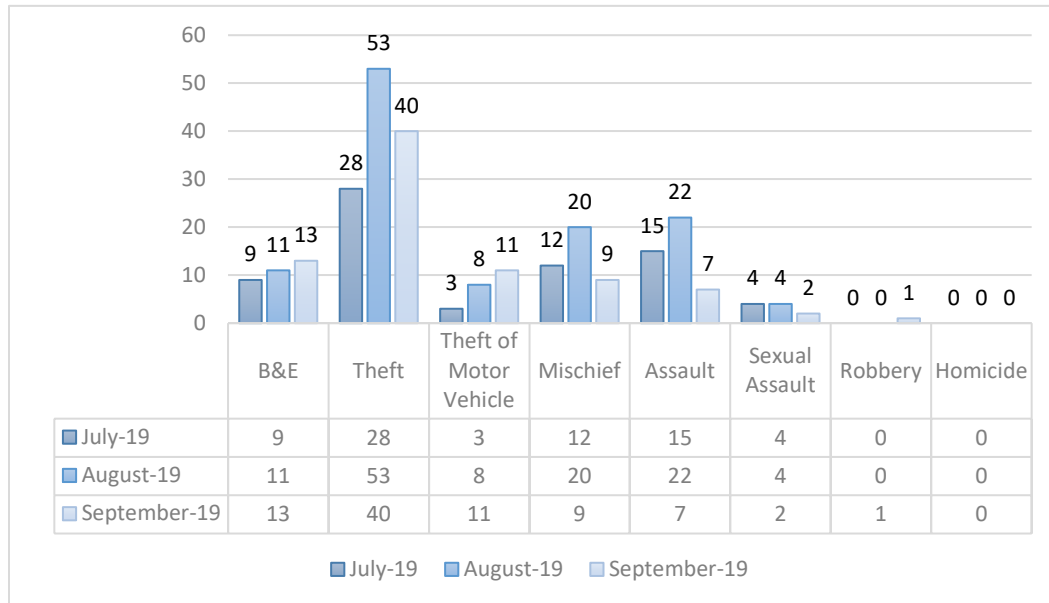

Overview:

The total of the Eight Crime Indicators decreased from August to September of 2019, however the total for September 2019 is twenty four (24) reported occurrences higher than September of 2018. The majority of the twenty four (24) occurrences were in the categories of thefts and thefts of motor vehicles.

Theft occurrences involved two (2) reports of thefts from a donation bin, the attempted theft of a trailer, two (2) incidents of internal thefts where cash and prescription medication were stolen, along with the theft of a generator, tools, a wheel chair, ornaments and shoes. Four (4) thefts of bicycle and one (1) report of theft from mail were also received. Twelve (12) reports of theft from motor vehicle were received which involved five (5) thefts of licence plates and one (1) report of theft of fuel, the theft of a dash camera, identification/cash and a diaper bag. Ten (10) reports of shoplifting were received as well as two (2) reports of theft over \$5,000 involving the theft of a trailer and diamond ring.

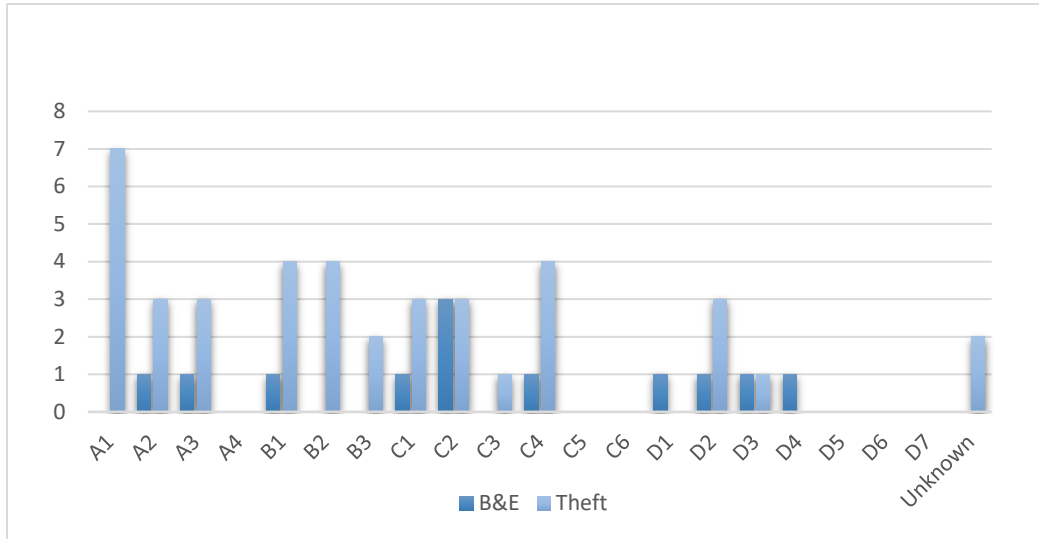
Eleven (11) reports of theft of motor vehicle were received in September 2019, which is a slight increase from the eight (8) reported occurrences in August 2019. Four (4) of the occurrences in September were attempted theft of motor vehicle and seven (7) of the occurrences were actual theft motor vehicles. Of the seven (7) actual theft of motor vehicles, four (4) of the vehicles have been recovered. A further break down is on Page #8 of this report.

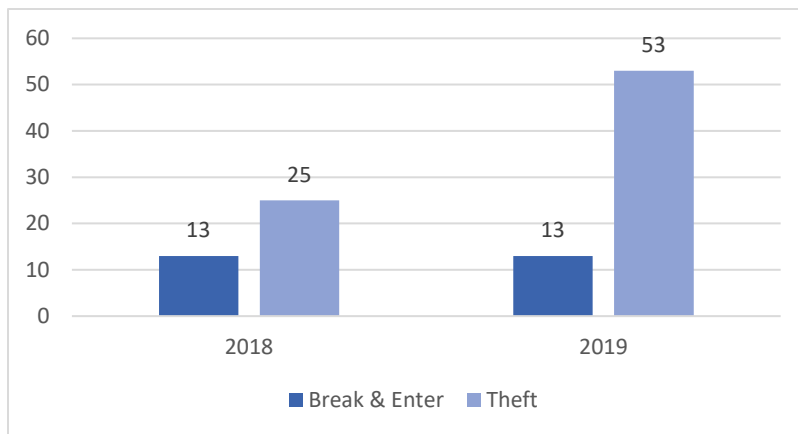

Break & Enter and Theft Occurrence Zones

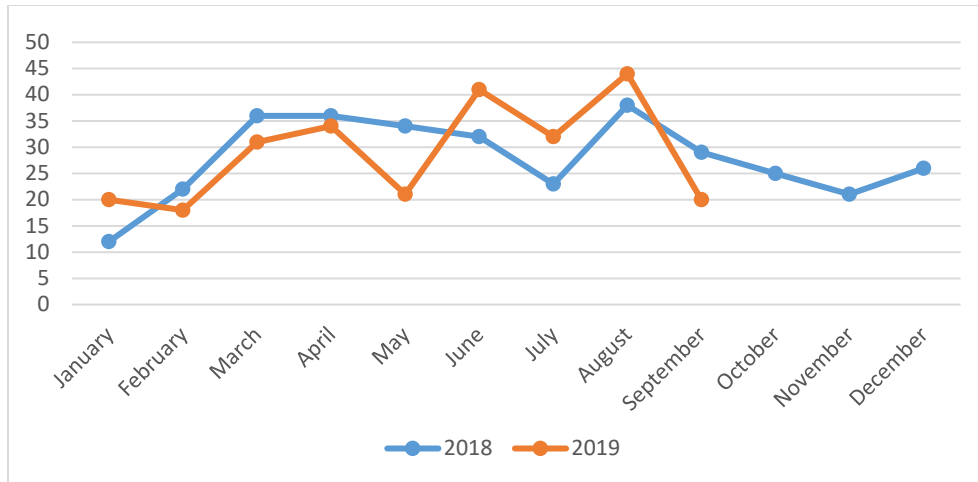


Break & Enter and Theft September 2018 to September 2019



Crimes Against Persons

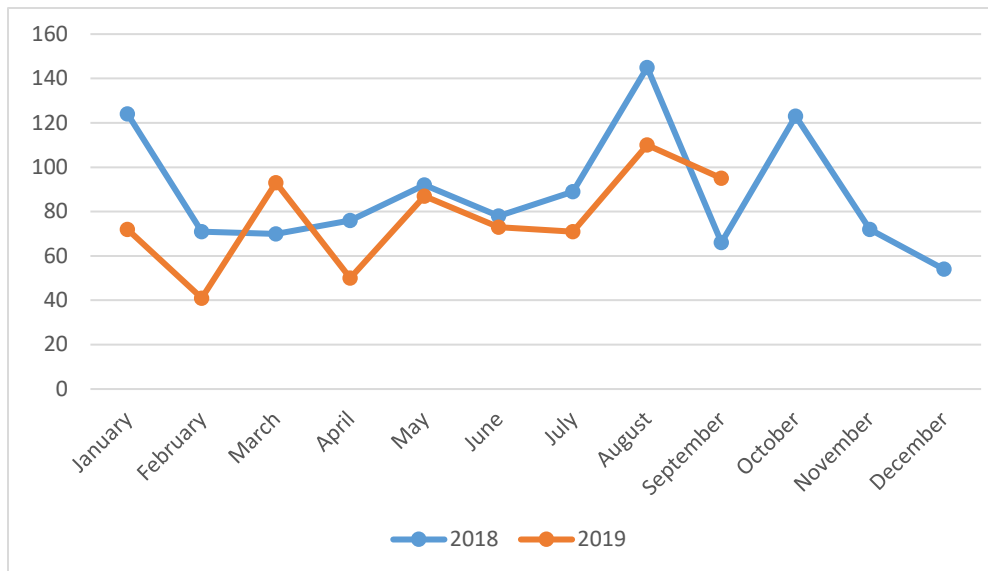
5 Year Monthly Average – 24

Crimes Against Property

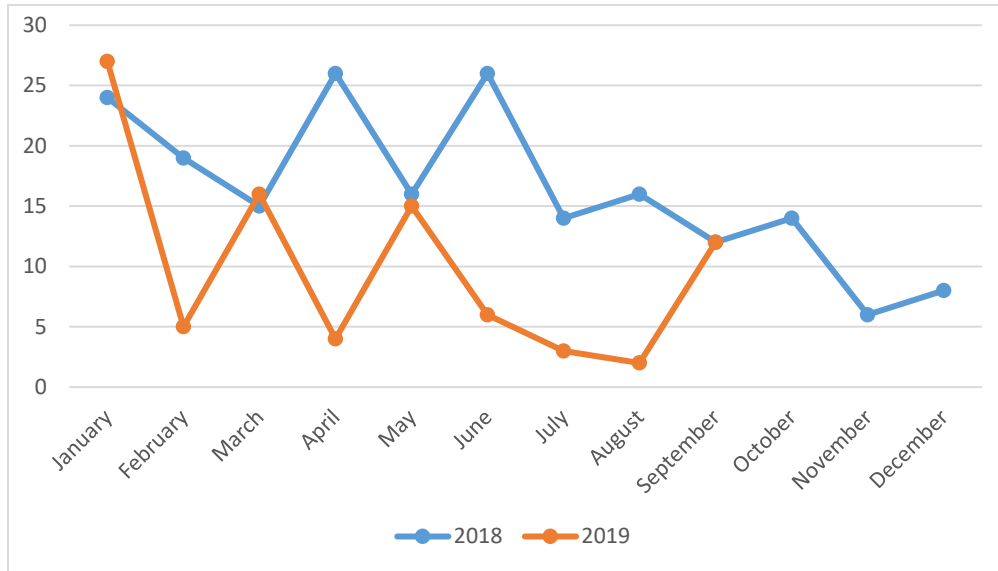
5 Year Monthly Average – 84

5 Year Monthly Average – 22



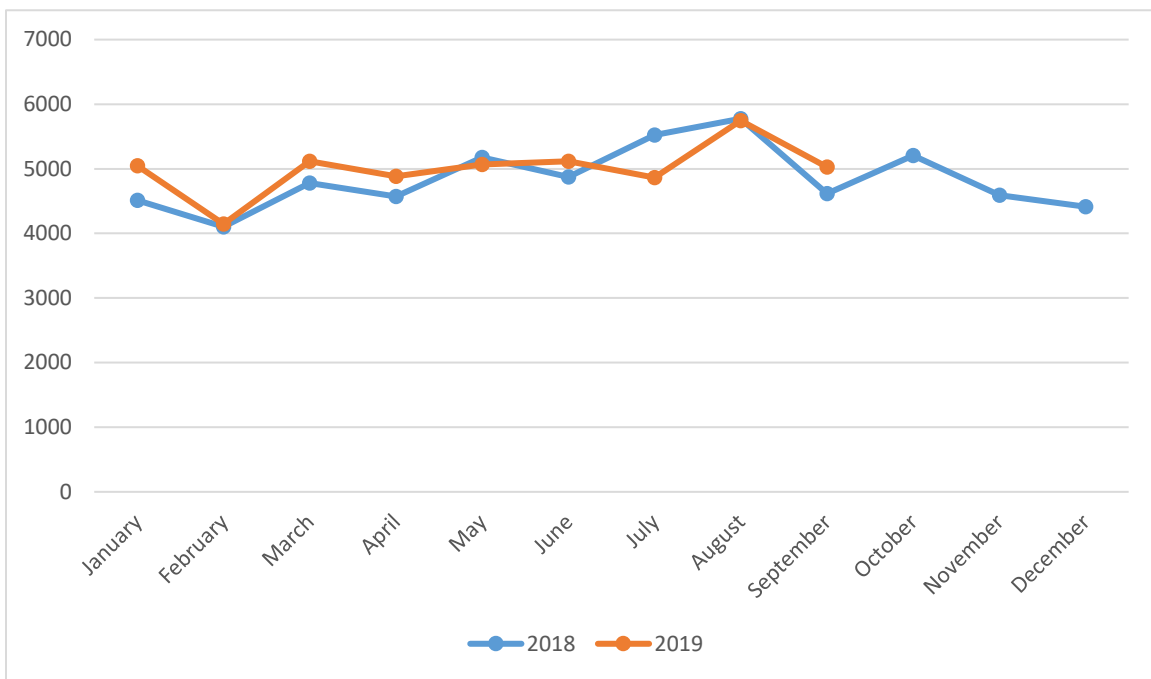

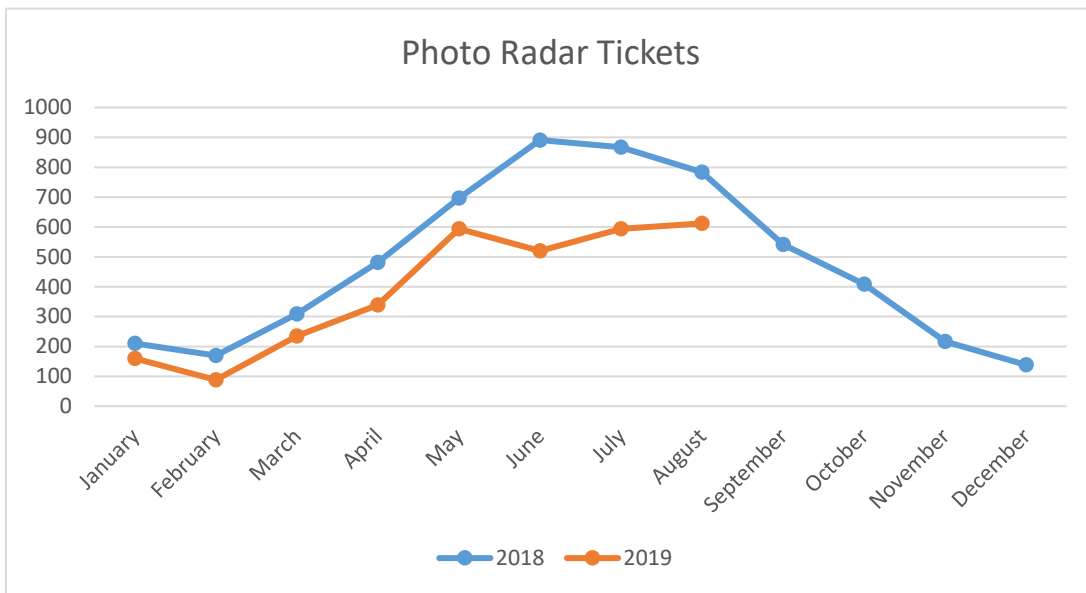
