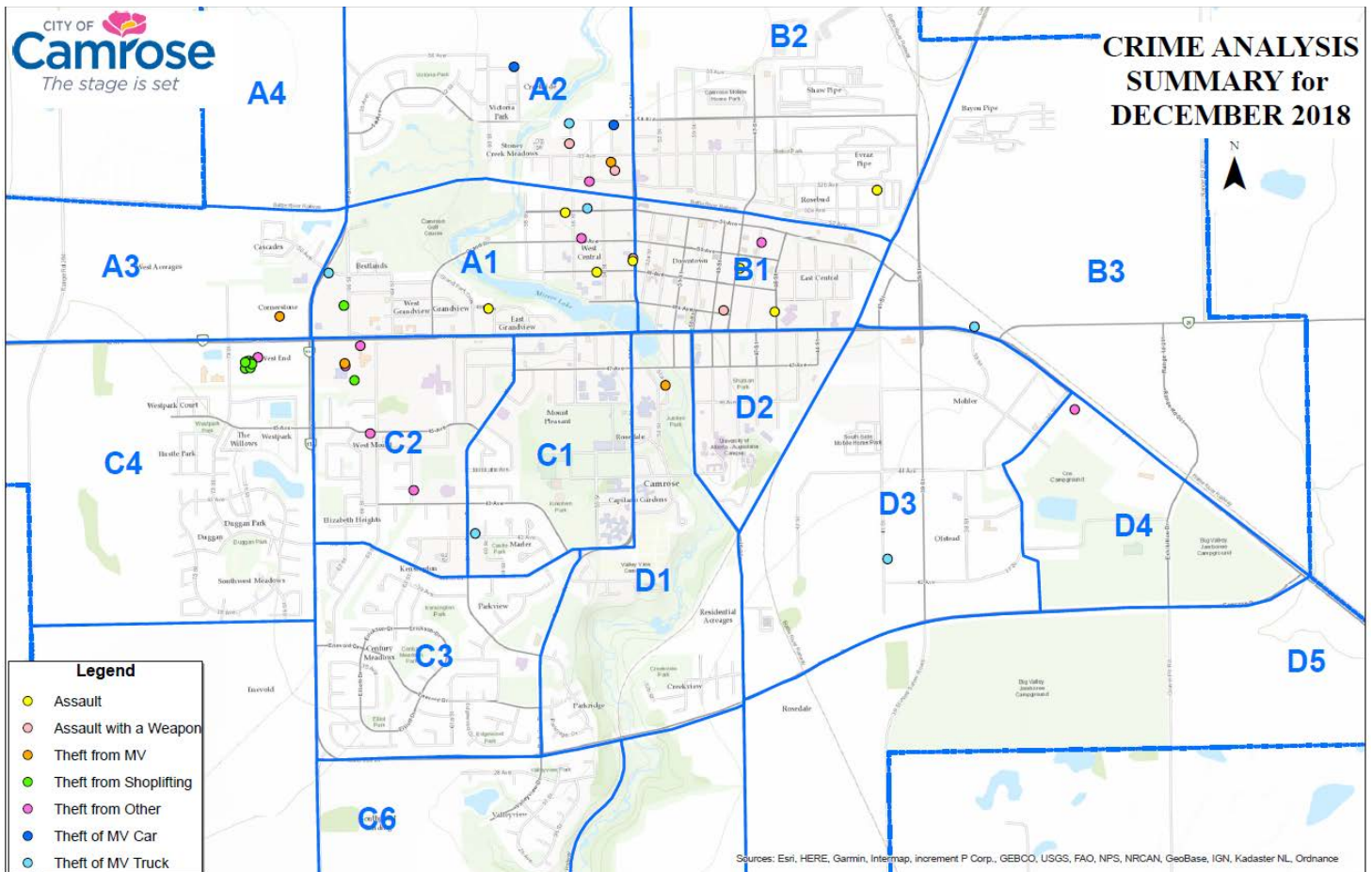
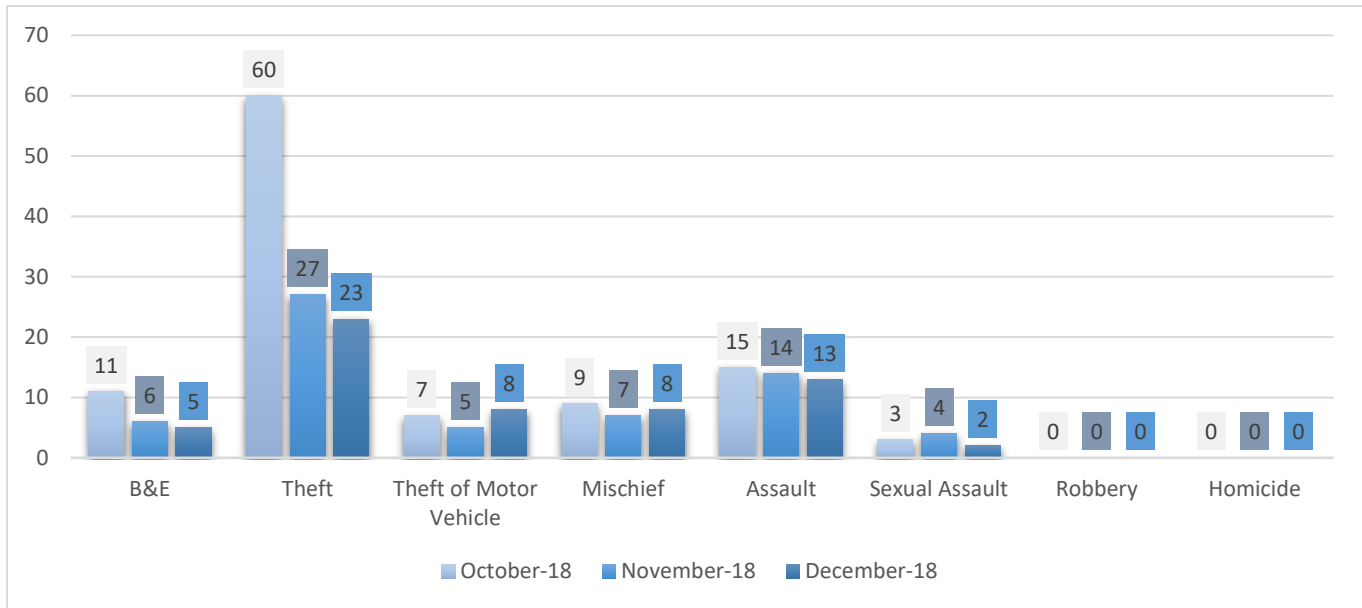

### **Overview:**

December 2018 recorded the lowest number of 8 Crime Indicators for all of 2018.

Theft occurrences saw a slight decrease from twenty seven (27) occurrences in November 2018, to twenty three (23) occurrences in December 2018. The majority of the theft occurrences involved shoplifting, where eight (8) of the ten (10) occurrences were at a business which employs full time loss prevention staff.

There were eight (8) recorded theft of motor vehicle occurrences. In half of these occurrences (4), the keys were left in the vehicle or the doors were unlocked. Three (3) of the eight (8) vehicles have been recovered. In two (2) of the occurrences, the suspect is known to the victim, and in three (3) occurrences charges have been laid or a suspect has been identified. There was one (1) attempted theft of a motor vehicle.

Assault occurrences remained consistent with the previous months. Eleven (11) of the thirteen (13) assault occurrences involved domestic violence or were familial in nature.

Crimes against property decreased from ninety (90) reported occurrences in December 2017, to fifty four (54) occurrences in December 2018. The majority of this decreased occurred in the categories of Fraud and B&E.

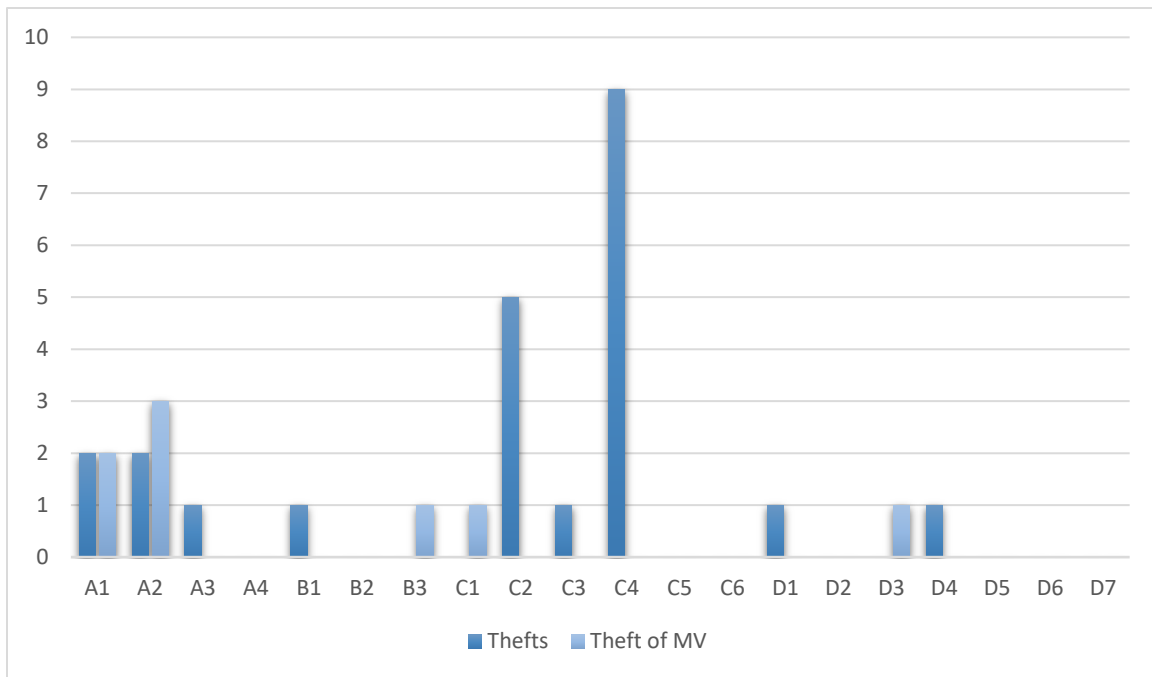

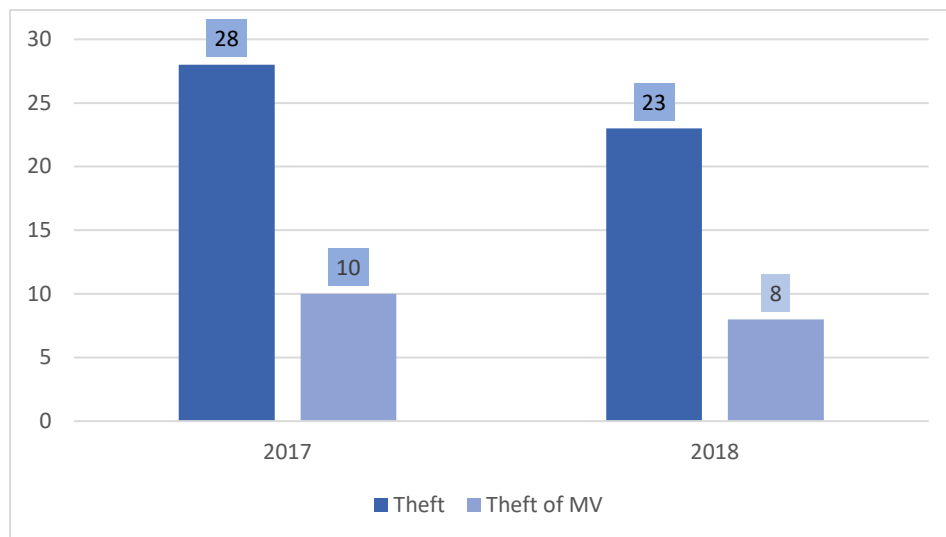
Information obtained from daily stats collections which varied by the end of the month due to scoring changes as a result of Police investigation.

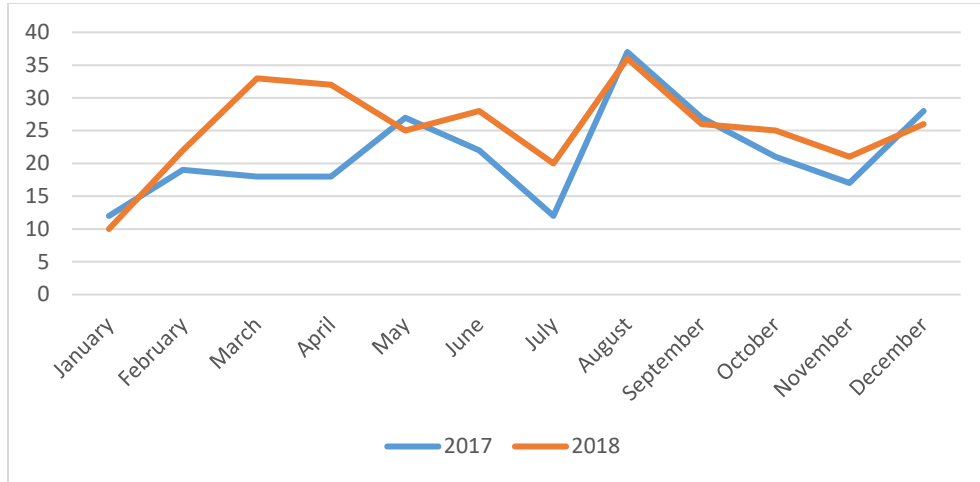
# Thefts and Theft of MV – Occurrence Zones



## Thefts and Theft of MV December 2017 to December 2018

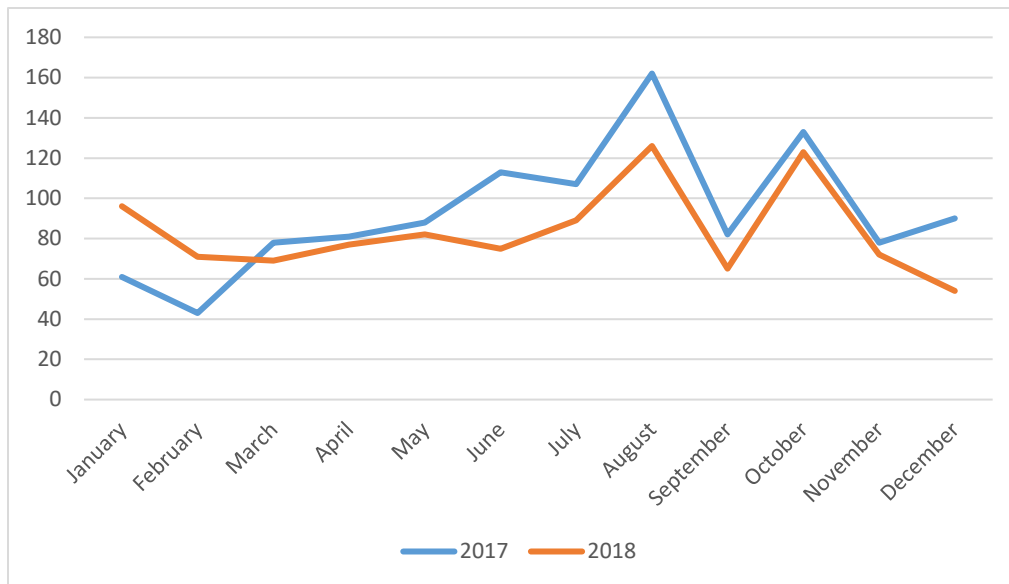


## Crimes Against Persons 5 Year Monthly Average – 24



The total number of Crimes against Persons was 26 in December of 2018, compared to 28 in December of 2017.

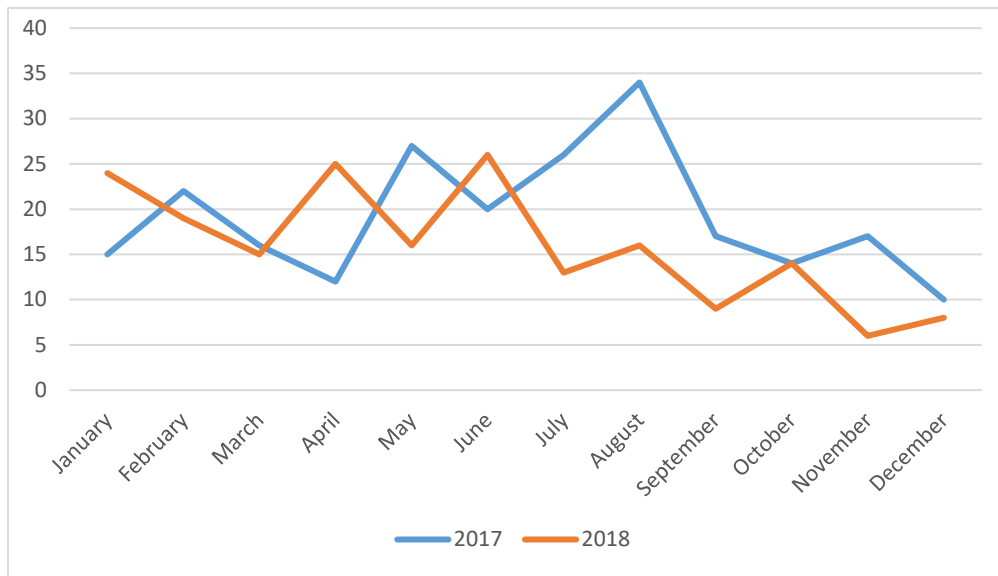
## Crimes Against Property 5 Year Monthly Average – 83

## 5 Year Monthly Average – 23

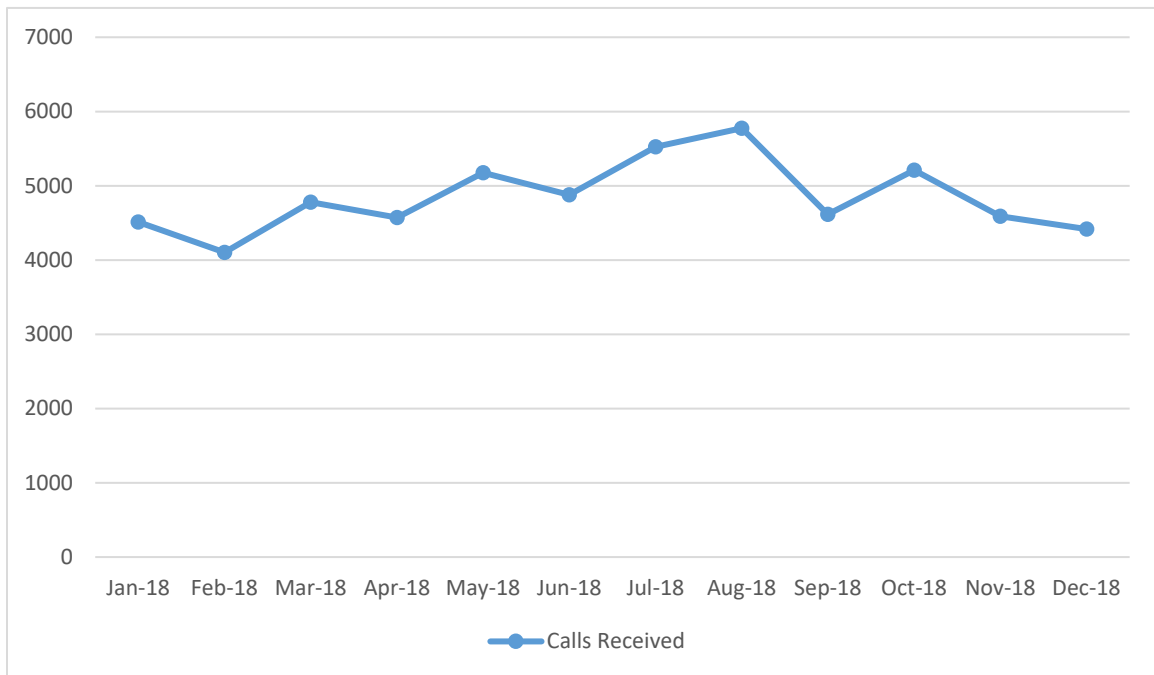


There were 8 drug offence occurrences in December of 2018, compared to 10 in December of 2017.



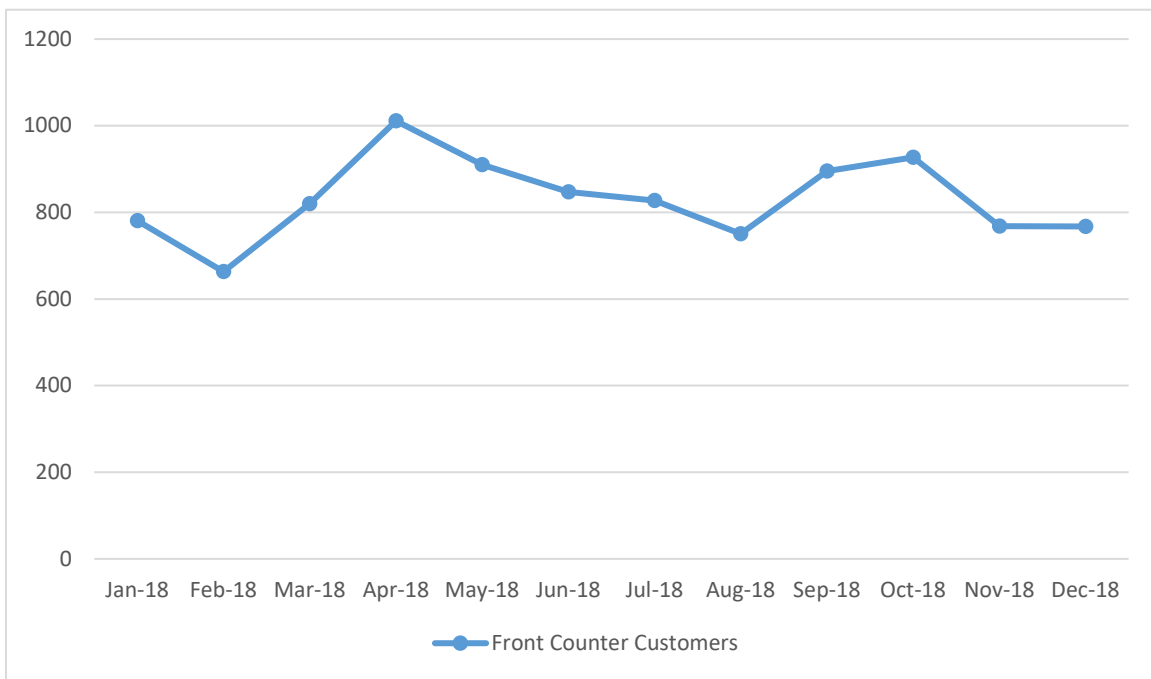

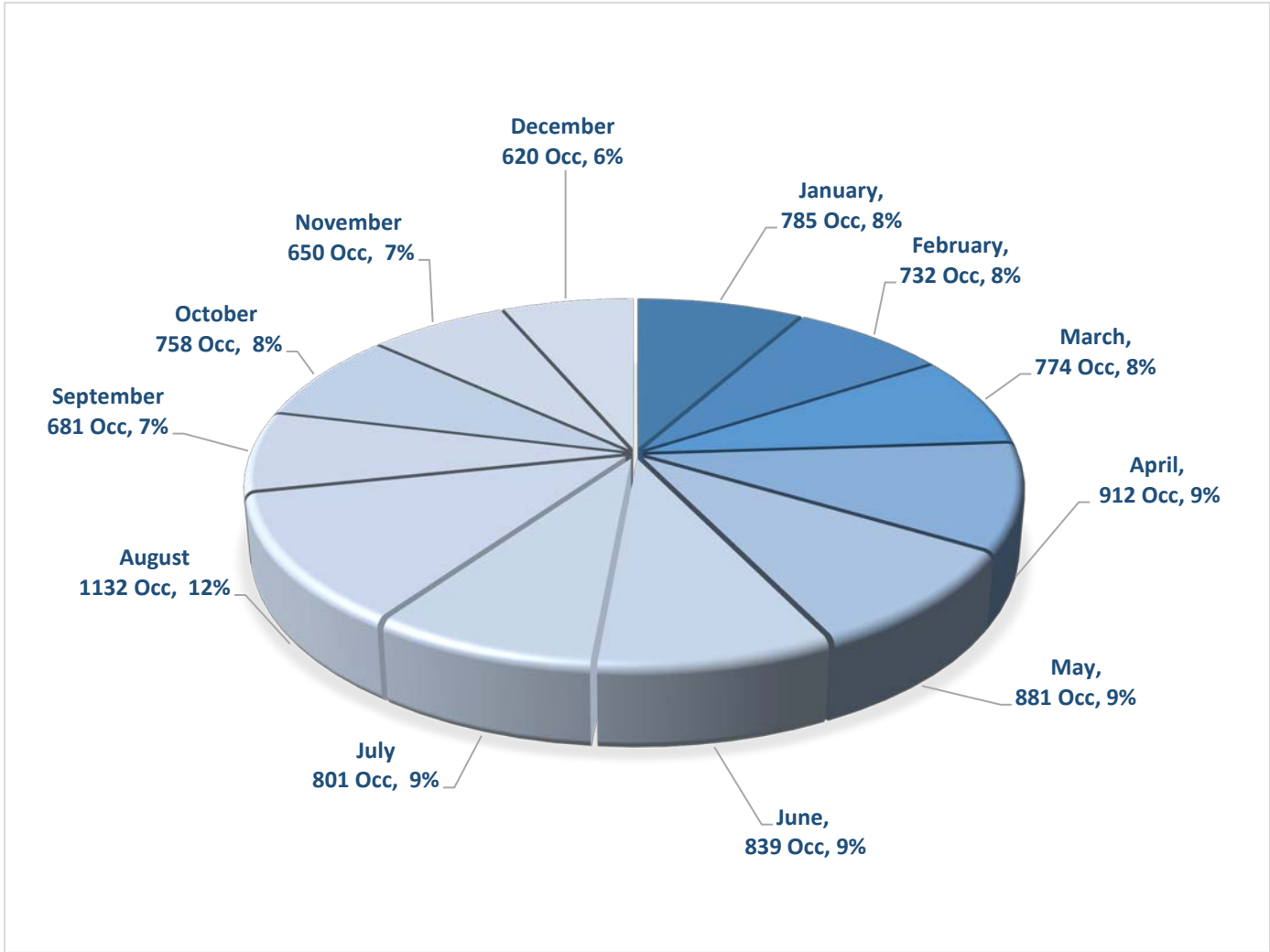

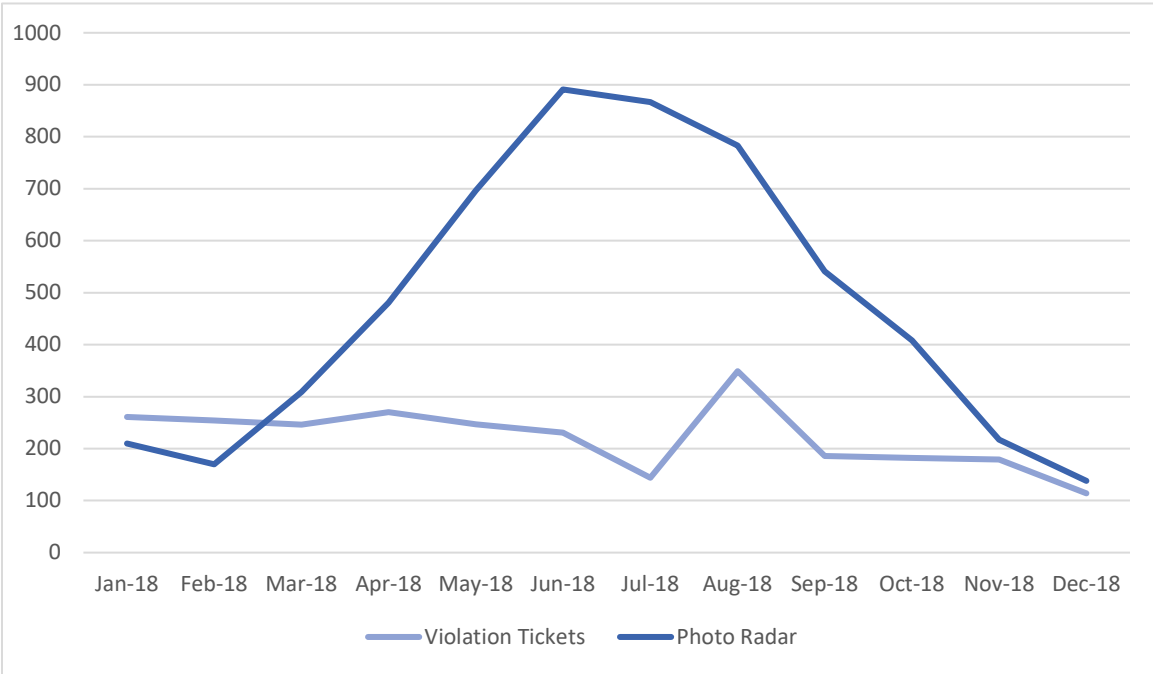
